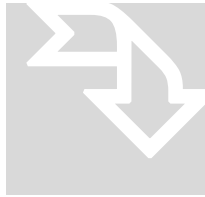

Bizyweb Installation

The Bizyweb installation is a step-by-step process. Please follow all steps.

Version 1.0 of Bizyweb utilizes an industry standard File Transfer Protocol (FTP) based installation process. This document describes the use of the FTP-based installation process in the context of the Yahoo! web hosting environment.

Installation Steps

STEPS
▪ Download the zip file and install document
▪ Create a folder called 'temp'
▪ Unzip downloaded file into the 'temp' folder
▪ Configure your FTP client
▪ FTP 'bw' folder to the root level of website
▪ Run the application

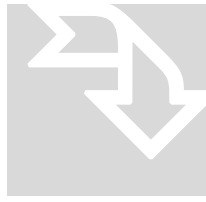
Each of the steps outlined here will be discussed individually. There are no changes made to the web server during installation. In the Appendix of this document, installation notes for specific web hosting firms are presented.

Important Notes

Bizyweb is co-located with your web server. Bizyweb requires PHP 4.3.2 or higher.

The application client is IE 6.0 or IE 7.0 in version 1.0. You **must** disable popups to run the Bizyweb application and the Internet connection should be DSL or faster to the application client.



Step 1: Detection of Previous Installation

The FTP-version of Bizyweb 1.0 resides in a folder called 'bw' located at the root level of the website. The root level is the same level as the index.html or index.php file of your website, as shown in the folder hierarchy below taken from Yahoo! webhosting.

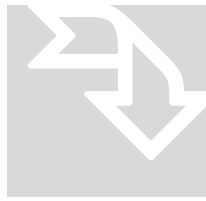
When installing using the FTP method, you may delete the previous version or install over it. If you install over it, then your **must** instruct your FTP client to write over or replace all existing files. Deleting the previous 'bw' version is recommended.

If the folder 'bw' is part of your website, then you must install Bizyweb to a different folder. Please see the Appendix for instructions on installing to a different folder.

Note that if you have previously installed the 'bzw' version from the Windows .exe installation, there is no need to delete the 'bzw' version. Multiple versions of the product can co-exist in different folders.

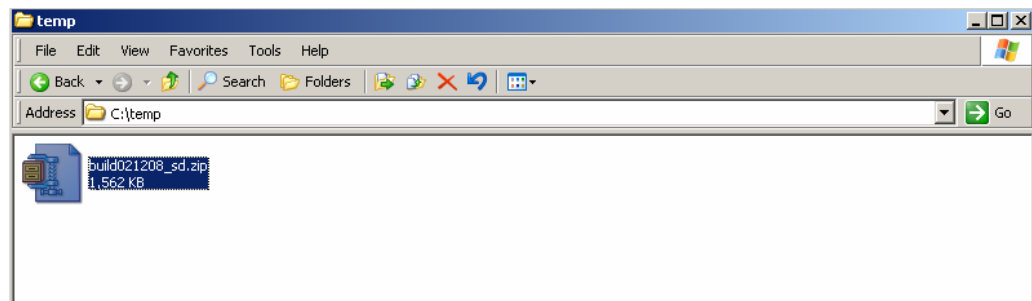

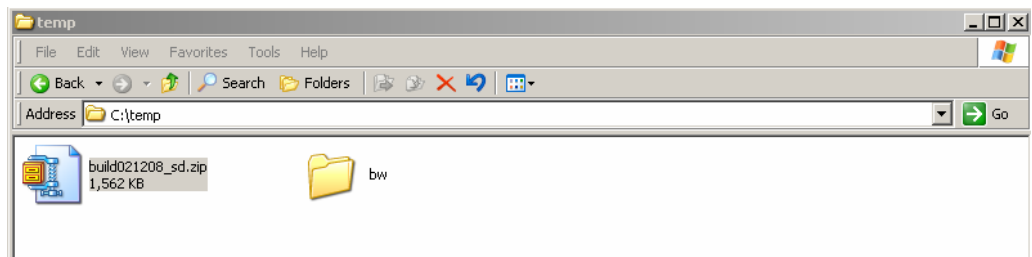
Step 2: Create 'Temp' directory and download Zip File

From the bizyweb.com site, a registered user can download the application from the download page. This installation document refers to the FTP version using a ZIP file which means that the file to be downloaded will end in .zip. If you download a file that ends in .exe, there is another installation document supporting an installation using the .exe file.

Create a folder called 'temp' on your system. Download the Zip file into the folder called 'temp'. It should look like this in a Windows environment. The same hierarchical relationships should be maintained on Unix or Linux..



Next, unzip the downloaded file. It should look like this:





Step 3: FTP Client Configuration

An FTP client is required for the FTP installation. There are many FTP clients for Windows available for download or purchase, such as Ipswitch WS_FTP Pro. If you are using IE6 or Firefox browser, FTP is built in to the browser. IE7 has changed its support for FTP, but you can FTP files directly from your XP desktop by double clicking on 'My Computer' and entering the FTP address into the address bar. The Yahoo! information needed to configure the FTP client is listed below.

The Yahoo! FTP address is as follows:

`ftp.yourdomain.suffix`

The Yahoo! FTP username is:

`Your-yahoo-userid@yourdomain.suffix`

Example:

If the domain is 'fashionfrenzy.com', then the ftp address is:

`ftp.fashionfrenzy.com`

If you login to Yahoo! as jane1970, then your user is:

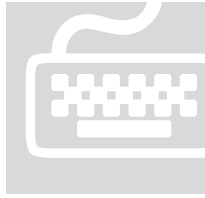
`jane1970@fashionfrenzy.com`

To use the Windows built-in FTP, double click 'My Computer' and enter the following in the address bar:

`ftp://jane1970@ftp.fashionfrenzy.com`

Prompted for the password, enter the Yahoo! password for the account 'jane1970'. Once authenticated, Windows will display the files on the Yahoo! website in a window with the label 'ftp://ftp.fashionfrenzy.com' displayed on top.

Open another Window containing the 'temp' folder. Arrange the 'ftp' folder and the 'temp' folders adjacent to one another. Then simply drag the 'bw' folder from the 'temp' folder into the 'ftp' folder. It will ask if you would like to replace existing files, say 'yes to all'. Using Windows built-in FTP appears to take longer than using an FTP-optimized client such as Ipswitch WS_FTP Pro. The amount to be transferred is about 6.75MB.



Step 4: Verify Installation

After the FTP has completed the transfer of the Bizyweb files, there should be a folder called 'bw' at the root as shown in the screenshot below taken from the Yahoo! File Manager. The root is the same level as the index.html file as shown here. For the 10 user multi-user version with Firefox support the folder is 'bwmu10ff'.

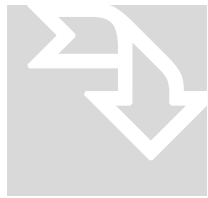

Step 5: Run the Application

To access the application, simply enter the following in the address line of the IE6, IE 7.0 browser or Firefox 2.0.

`http://www.yourdomain.com/bw` (single user)

`http://www.yourdomain.com/bwmu10ff` (multi-user 10 with Firefox)

You should see the following authentication form. The default userid and password are 'bizyAdmin' and 'bizypass' respectively. Once inside the application, click on User Administration and change the password. The beta version is a single user only, so you will not be able to add or delete users to this version.

Appendix: Shared Web Hosting Tested

The following comments relate to the FTP version of the installation (bw)

1. Yahoo! - no problems detected
2. HostGator - no problems detected (Linux plan)
3. Bizland – PHP had previously been enabled; Charter plan; no problems detected.
4. Interserver.net – existing Linux account; PHP must be enabled;
5. 1&1 – no problems detected (Linux plan)
6. GoDaddy – Linux account; change the following in the php.ini to be:
allow_url_fopen = on (defaults to off)
7. IXWebhosting – no issues

Appendix: Changing the Installation Folder

The file 'inc/properties.inc' contains a parameter 'bizy_home'. It is set to 'bw' in the single user version and 'bwmu10ff' in the ten user version and 'bwmu25ff' in the 25 user version.

You must change this to the folder you would like to use. This folder **MUST** be at the root level. Do not change any other parameters without instructions.

```
define('BIZY_HOME','bw');
```

However, the 'properties' file is obfuscated, as is all of the code, so it should not be edited.

In the enterprise version of bizyweb, this file will be configurable..
